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NEW SOUND SYSTEM TO TAKE CENTRE STAGE AT FESTIVAL OF LIGHTS

The Festival of Lights will sound much clearer this summer thanks to ten generous partners and a new enhancement of speaker towers at Del Crary Park.

Bill Hereault of Soundpro, the Festival's technical company says "these new rigging towers are a portable structure that will allow us to suspend the speakers up to 30ft in the air, giving us a full coverage of the park from front to back and keeping more of the sound in the park."

Kathy Kirkland, General Manager of the Peterborough Summer Festival of Lights is excited about the new speaker system saying: "this has been a goal of the Festival for many many years. These new structures will allow us to move our event yet another step forward and really bring the Festival into the 21st century."
